## eRAD Announces the Release of Version 7.0 Featuring Image Sharing Capabilities

Not only can the images be uploaded securely but scanned documents and electronic medical records can also be added to the patient file.

eRAD's hosted cloud based service is used by teleradiology service providers, community and academic based reading groups worldwide and is projected to process over one million studies this year. Other key features of the version 7.0 release include integrated Autofaxing, batch study assignment tools, enhanced enterprise reporting and accounting capabilities for billing.
